


Overview and Background of Goa: The Tourism State

### Government initiatives



### Transaction Process

- The Project will be awarded through international competitive bidding following a singlestage bidding process
- This involves the submission of a Technical and Financial bid through the e-tendering portal of the Government of Goa.
- The technical bid will be opened first and the Applicants who fulfil the requirements as per the provisions of the Request for Proposal ('RFP') will be shortlisted for opening of the financial bid. Once shortlisted the financial bid will be the bidding parameter for this process.
- Interested entities may download the bid document by following the procedure outlines below:
  - 1. Obtain a Class III Digital certificate from one of the approved vendors
  - 2. Register on www.tenderwizard.com/GOA by paying the annual registration fee
  - 3. Login to the site and request for the Bid Documents for the relevant property on the portal from the tenders listed under Goa Tourism Development Corporation
  - 4. Pay Tender Processing Fee & Cost of Bid Document applicable
  - On receipt of tender processing fee and cost of bid documents, the Bid documents shall be issued electronically
  - 6. Upload required documents and submit the tender online.
