Overview and **Background of Goa: The Tourism** State

- The smallest state in India spread over 3,702 sq.km with a beautiful coastline, lush forests, hospitable people and a rich culture
- A destination of choice for international (0.5 mn) and domestic tourists (3.5 mn) in
- No 6. on the list of top 10 nightlife cities in the world as rated by National Geographic²
- Permanent venue of the International Film Festival of India (IFFI)
- 2014 saw an increase of 30%1 in tourist arrivals due to various marketing initiatives, short break tourists and the exposition of St. Francis Xavier

Hospitality industry in Goa

- Tourism is an important sector for the Goan economy, contributing 12.5% to the local GDP3
- Goa is one of the few destinations in India which has witnessed a consistently rising trend in hotel occupancy for star category hotels. This is despite an increase in the room supply which is illustrated in the graph below

Theme Park and Ecotourism related activities in India

- According to the India Association of Amusement Parks and Industry (IAPPI), the industry in India is worth over 2,500 crore INR and is expected to reach 5,400 crore INR by 2020. There are currently over 150 amusement and water parks in India.
- With a large number of families visiting and the existence of a high demand for family oriented entertainment activities in Goa there is significant potential for the industry.
- Goa was awarded the best wellness destination at IITM Chennai, Best Eco-Tourism State at IITM Gurgaon and the 'Best Value Destination (India)' by Lonely Planet Magazine - India.
- About 10% of the total land in Goa has been set aside as a wildlife reserve (including Wildlife Sanctuary's) and 600kms of India's Western Ghats runs within the state4.

Government initiatives

- The Government is encouraging private investment in Goa through the Goa Investment Policy 2014
- The Goa Investment Promotion and Facilitation Board has been created to provide a single window clearance to projects and facilitate investment in Goa
- GTDC has introduced new tourism services such as hot air ballooning, amphibious vehicle tours, Segway tours, horse trails, sea plane services, luxury yacht services etc. to boost tourism in Goa
- Infrastructure investments such as the upcoming Mopa International Airport, conversion of the Konkan railway tracks from single to double lining and the development of several highways linking Goa to its neighboring states have been made
- The Government is all set to target higher spending tourists by providing visa on arrival facilities to nationals from over 150 countries

- GTDC was established by the Government of Goa as an autonomous body in 1982 to look after commercial tourism activities of the Government of Goa and develop tourism infrastructure
- GTDC promotes Goa as an International tourism destination by participating in trade shows, travel fares and tourism travel marts globally
- GTDC operates 13 tourism hotels with 550 rooms and 1,307⁵ beds across Goa.
 They also have several land parcels which are to be utilized for developing tourism infrastructure in Goa
- GTDC is increasing its focus on its core activities and service mission while the non-core activities are carries out via private partners
- GTDC is the Concessioning Authority for this transaction



Transaction Process

- The Project will be awarded through international competitive bidding following a singlestage bidding process
- This involves the submission of a Technical and Financial bid through the e-tendering portal of the Government of Goa.
- The technical bid will be opened first and the Applicants who fulfil the requirements as per the provisions of the Request for Proposal ('RFP') will be shortlisted for opening of the financial bid. Once shortlisted the financial bid will be the bidding parameter for this process.
- Interested entities may download the bid document by following the procedure outlines below:
 - Obtain a Class III Digital certificate from one of the approved vendors
 - 2. Register on www.tenderwizard.com/GOA by paying the annual registration fee
 - Login to the site and request for the Bid Documents for the relevant property on the portal from the tenders listed under Goa Tourism Development Corporation
 - 4. Pay Tender Processing Fee & Cost of Bid Document applicable
 - On receipt of tender processing fee and cost of bid documents, the Bid documents shall be issued electronically
 - 6. Upload required documents and submit the tender online.
